

# COLUMBUS, DOWLING IN FINAL

AMES, IA. — Craig Brown and Chuck Boesen each scored two goals as defending champ Columbus of Waterloo outted Valley of West Des Moines, 5-1, in the semifinal round of the state high school club hockey tournament Saturday night.

Columbus of Waterloo will face Dowling — 3-0 winner over Urbandale — for the championship today.

In semifinal consolation contests, Brian Hartman's four goals sparked Sioux City past Ankeny, 6-1, Roosevelt-Hoover of Des Moines, behind Scott Sutherland's hat trick, edged Public of Waterloo, 4-3, in overtime. Roosevelt-Hoover will face Sioux City today at 10 a.m. in the consolation final.

Columbus upended Roosevelt-Hoover of Des Moines, 7-1, Friday night in the first round as Craig Brown scored two goals. Dowling beat Ankeny, 6-2, in another opening-round game.
