AMES, IA. — The top two scorers in the Iowa Hockey League will clash when Urbandale (6-6) faces Sioux City (4-7-1) at 10 a.m. Friday to open the second annual state high school tournament at Hilton Coliseum.

Sioux City's Brian Hartman led the league with 22 goals and eight assists for 30 points during the regular season, and Urbandale's Randy Higgins was No. 2 with 16 goals and eight assists for 24 points.

The high school tourney, held in conjunction with the Big Eight Invitational tourney, concludes with the championship game at 8 p.m. Sunday.

In Friday's other opening-round games, Des Moines Metro Conference champion Valley of West Des Moines (7-4-1) meets Public of Waterloo (4-8) at noon, Dowling (8-4) battles Ankeny (6-1 and winner of the Division II state crown) at 5 p.m., and Iowa League champion Columbus of Waterloo (10-2) takes on Roosevelt-Hoover of Des Moines (2-10) at 7 p.m.

Columbus is led by Craig Brown, who during the regular season had 23 points on eight goals and 15 assists.

The semifinals will be Saturday; a consolation game is scheduled for noon Sunday.

Iowa State opens the Big Eight tourney against Kansas at 2 p.m. Friday, and Nebraska faces Colorado at 9 p.m.
