

# Sailors win; Public falls 5-1

DES MOINES—Columbus High of Waterloo breezed by Urbandale 9-1 while Waterloo Public was eliminated from the championship bracket Thursday night in the opening round of the state high school hockey tournament here.

Public fell to Dowling of West Des Moines 5-1 in the tournament's opening game.

The Sailors were tied with Urbandale, the last place finisher in Iowa High School League division I team standings, 1-1 at the end of the first period. But, Columbus then tallied a pair of goals in the second and scored a half-dozen more in the third.

Chuck Boesen and Kevin Landau each scored twice for the Sailors.
