**DES MOINES** — Waterloo's Warriors appear poised to reclaim the state hockey championship they lost to Des Moines Public last year after three rounds of the 1985 state tournament at the Des Moines Ice Arena here.

The Warriors swept to three sound victories, two Friday and one Saturday, and must defeat Sioux City Sunday morning to move into the 6 p.m. championship game against the winner of the Ames-Urbandale game Sunday.

Things haven't gone nearly so well for Waterloo's second entrant in the tournament, Columbus. The Sailors have dropped all three of their games and must win their game at 6:45 a.m. Sunday to play for fifth place.

Several Warriors have been outstanding early in the tournament. Unofficially, senior Brian Cook has scored seven goals and has five assists. T.J. Saul has five goals and three assists. Defenseman Robbie Brown has seven assists. Dan Michelsen has two goals and three assists. Tim Bartz has seven assists.

In Saturday's games, the Warriors dumped Sioux City 8-3 before the Metros came back to edge Columbus 4-3.

And, while the Sailors' offense was sputtering in a pair of two-goal performances Friday, the Warriors' attack was in high gear.

Columbus lost its first game in the tournament, 4-2, to a Mason City team the Sailors defeated twice during the regular season by 7-1 and 6-5 margins. This time around, Mohawk goalie Doug Tarr turned away 31 shots and his team scored twice in the third period to break a 2-2 deadlock.

Waterloo's Warriors made their debut with a 6-2 win over Valley-Dowling, which they also defeated twice during the regular season. They had 53 shots on goal in that game.

In the second session Friday, Urbandale trimmed Columbus 6-2 behind Troy Johnson's hat trick and the Warriors belted Mason City, 8-2.

Columbus lost not only the game, but Coach Jim Smith on a game disqualification.

The Sailors fell behind 5-0 before Joel Jasper put them on the board in a second period that could have made the game a blowout were it not for the play of Columbus goaltender Pat

Lanigan.

Lanigan, who finished with 44 saves, swatted away 26 in the second period when the Sailors skated short-handed almost the entire 15 minutes. In fact, both of their goals in the game came when Urbandale had a player advantage.

In all, 23 penalties were whistled, 14 against Columbus. Smith was disqualified after the game was over when he allowed his players to shake hands with the Urbandale team. The referees asked the teams not to meet in light of the type of game it had been, according to assistant Sailor coach Mike Brown.

Cook and Saul each scored hat tricks as the Warriors belted Mason City. Defensively, meanwhile, Waterloo held the Mohawks to seven shots on goal over the first two periods and 18 for the game.

Saturday's play wrapped up the preliminary rounds of the tournament and left Ames, the Warriors and Urbandale each with 3-0 records. Sioux City claimed fourth place and a spot in the upper bracket opposite the Warriors by defeating Mason City in a 10-minute playoff, 1-0.

By the tournament tie-breaking system, Ames is still the top seed with the Warriors second and Urbandale third.
