Waterloo Warriors meet Sioux City for championship

WATERLOO — The Waterloo Warriors upset Waterloo Columbus 7-5 Saturday and will face Sioux City Metro for the championship today in the state high school hockey tournament.

The Warriors (15-6-1) meet Sioux City (16-6-2) at 4 p.m., preceded at 2 p.m. by the third-place game between Columbus (19-3-0) and West Des Moines Valley-Dowling (17-6-1). Sioux City edged Valley-Dowling, 4-3, in semifinal action Saturday.

In consolation round games Saturday, Dubuque eliminated Mason City, 6-4; and Urbandale defeated Ames, 8-2. Mason City fell 7-3 to Omaha on Friday and bowed out at 0-23 against Iowa teams and 4-28 overall.

Meeting for fifth place this morning are Omaha (10-12-2) and Urbandale (8-16-1). Opponents facing off for seventh are Ames (8-15-0) and Dubuque (8-14-1).
