

# Metros, Dubuque to tangle in prep hockey tournament

WATERLOO, Iowa — The Sioux City Metros open play in the 1990 Iowa High School Hockey League post-season tournament tonight, meeting Dubuque at McElroy Auditorium here.

The game is slated to start at 9 o'clock.

The Metros sport a 14-6-2 record entering the tourney and Dubuque is 7-12-1. Sioux City finished second to West Des Moines Valley-Dowling in the West Division regular-season standings.

Valley-Dowling won the division with a 16-5-1 record.

Omaha was 9-11-2 in the division and Urbandale 6-15-1. In the East Division, Waterloo Columbus won with an 18-2-0 record, followed by Waterloo Public (13-6-1), Dubuque,

Ames (7-13-0) and Mason City (0-20-0).

Sioux City and Valley-Dowling would meet in the second round Friday if both win tonight. Valley-Dowling meets Ames tonight.

Sioux City's Brett Austin and T.J. Reinsch finished in a tie for 11th in IHSHL scoring with 38 points each. Austin had 25 goals and 13 assists and Reinsch 24 goals and 14 assists.

Sioux City's Chris Sorum had 14 goals and 20 assists for 34 points and Jesse Monell 12 goals and 12 assists for 24 points.

Metros goaltenders Jeff Brogan and Jesse Basarich boast 10-3-1 and 4-3-1 records, respectively. Brogan has allowed 51 goals and Basarich 34.
