

Warriors settle for 8th place in state tournament

SIOUX CITY — The Waterloo Warriors finished their high school hockey season with a 7-3 loss to Valley-Dowling of Des Moines here Sunday morning in the state tournament's seventh-place game.

Host Sioux City dumped Mason City, 5-2, Sunday afternoon for the championship.

Waterloo allowed four goals in the second period as Des Moines broke open a 1-1 game. Todd Johnson scored twice for the winners while Jeff Furtwangler and Brad Petersen each had a goal and two assists.

Brett Klima scored the first two goals for the Warriors and assisted on the third by Benji Buckley. Buckley and Chad Fordyce had two assists apiece for Waterloo, which got two of its goals on the power play.

Warrior goaltender Chris Abbott faced 37 shots in the game while

Waterloo again struggled to get scoring chances. The Warriors managed just 11 shots on goal over the first two periods.
