

Metros fall in state meet

DES MOINES — Mike McCollum's second goal of the game broke a 1-all tie and sent Des Moines past Sioux City, 2-1, in the first round of the Iowa High School Hockey League playoffs here at Des Moines Ice Arena Friday night.

The loss dropped the Metros into a consolation-round game today at 10:30 a.m. against either Mason City or Waterloo. They played the late game Friday night.

Sioux City, the 1994 IHSHL champion, takes a 22-13 mark into today's consolation contest. The Metros are 16-11 in IHSHL games.

McCollum scored his second red-lighter at 9:36 of the final period. Pat Miller got the assist and Ryan Sandahl the second assist.

It was Des Moines' third victory this year over Coach Jim Peck's skaters. All three games have been in Des Moines.

Des Moines goalie Matt Garrison stopped 19 shots while Sioux City netminder Damon Keith turned away 26 shots.

After a scoreless first period, Sioux City grabbed a 1-0 lead when Chresten Jensen scored at 12:41.

Des Moines tied the game on McCollum's first goal, a red-lighter at 13:16 in the second period.

Des Moines, seeded fourth, upped its record to 18-8-1 in IHSHL action with the win.

Omaha's two entries, the Gladiators and Junior Lancers, were winners in Friday's first round action. Ames and Waterloo won pig-tail contests.
