

Three Metros in all-star hockey tilt

An all-star team made up of players from the Iowa High School Hockey League, including three players from the Sioux City Metros, competed in the Chicago Showcase Tournament all-star game this weekend.

Goaltender Damon Keith and forwards Mark Munger and Walt Johnson represented Sioux City on the IHSHL all-star squad, known as Tri-State, made up of juniors and seniors. The Tri-State team won three games in pool play to advance to the final eight in the 24-team field, their best-ever finish in the tournament.

Tri-State registered a 5-2 win over Team Southwest, a 4-0 shut out against Northwest and a 2-2 tie against California to place first in its half of the pool. Tri-State then posted a 6-3 win over Washington-Alaska in the pool finals, but lost to Minnesota 9-1 in the final eight.
