

Warriors blank Ames, then drop two

OMAHA, Neb. — After winning their opening game, the Waterloo Warriors dropped a pair and will play Kanaz City for seventh place in the Iowa High School Hockey league tournament today at 8 a.m..

The Warriors handed Ames a 1-0 defeat in the preliminary round Friday. Later Friday night, Waterloo fell to the top-seeded Des Moines team, 3-1. In the consolation round Saturday, Mason City topped Waterloo, 6-3.

Waterloo's Honza Kubicek scored the only goal of the game against the Little Cyclones at the 13:17 mark. Ben Kutz was credited with the assist.

Against Des Moines, Waterloo fell behind 2-0 in the second before the Warriors got on the board in the third when Mike Messerer scored with an assist from Kutz.

In Saturday's loss, Luke McCarty, Bob Brady, and Jon Schell each scored for Waterloo, but Mason City scored the final three goals to break a 3-3 tie and claim the win.

The Capitals ended the regular season with a 19-6-1 league mark. Saturday, Des Moines fell to the Omaha Junior Lancers, 3-0. Also earning a spot in the title contest set for 3:30 this afternoon was Sioux City with a 3-1

win over the Omaha Gladiators.
