

Metros drop consolation game at state

URBANDALE, Iowa — Quad Cities rallied from a 2-1 deficit to score four unanswered third-period goals in a 5-2 win over the Sioux City Metros in a consolation game Saturday morning at the Iowa High School Hockey League state tournament.

John Adam scored both Sioux City goals. The junior forward from Bishop Heelan High School gave the Metros a 2-1 lead when he scored on Ben Schmidt's assist at the 2:18

mark of the third period.
