

Tuttle, Bauer score for Team Midwest

BENSENVILLE, Ill. — Andrew Bauer and Marshall Tuttle of the Sioux City Metros each scored goals for Team Midwest in a 4-4 tie with Team Missouri in pool play action at the Chicago Showcase hockey tournament here Friday.

Bauer, a junior from West, scored the first goal for Team Midwest at 16:14 while Tuttle, a senior from East High, had a goal at 12:24 of the second period. Each player also tallied goals in 5-2 win over Team Colorado on Thursday.

Team Midwest, though, finished pool play with a 1-0-2 mark and did not qualify for the quarterfinals. The top eight teams in the 24-team high school boys division, comprised of three eight-team pools, advanced to Sunday's quarterfinals.

Team Midwest also battled to a 1-1 tie with Team Indiana on Wednesday.

Tuttle was the most valuable player for the Metros this season while Bauer was awarded the team's Dustin White Memorial Award.
