

Caps clip Warriors at state hockey, 6-2

URBANDALE — Waterloo dropped out of the championship bracket of the Midwest High School Hockey League tournament quickly Friday, as the Des Moines Capitals handed the Warriors a 6-2 defeat.

Waterloo spotted Des Moines four unanswered goals and could never catch up in the duel between the No. 5 and No. 4 seeds. Jake Irey tallied both of the Warrior goals, one early in the second period and the other late in the third.

Waterloo pulled within 4-2 in the final minutes, but the Capitals added two scores to set the total.

"We didn't sit back," said Warriors head coach Shawn Weinke. "We were aggressive and (the Capitals) took advantage of that."

"I preach to our guys to be aggressive, and after they scored, we had to get after it. We were almost too aggressive. I called timeout and we got things back together, but we couldn't get anything going. We had opportunities — that's for sure. We didn't finish like they did. They did a nice job of finishing."

The Warriors move into consolation play today at 10:15 a.m.
