Metros fall in consolation round at league tourney

AMES, Iowa — Trevor Tix and Spencer Warren each scored two goals for Waterloo, which rallied from a 2-0 deficit to take a 7-2 win over the Sioux City Metros in a consolation-round game Saturday morning at the Midwest High School Hockey League Tournament held at the Ames/ISU Ice Arena.

Seventh-seeded Sioux City, which opened the tournament with a 3-0 loss Friday to the Kansas City Junior Outlaws, got a firstperiod goal at the 3:43 mark by Mitchell Vos. Colton Kramer followed with his 43rd goal of the season at the 14:30 mark to give the Metros a 2-0 lead.

Waterloo, a 3-2 first-round loser to the Kansas City Stars, scored 11 seconds following Kramer's goal on a goal from Spencer Warren. The Warriors took the lead for keeps on second-period goals from Tix and Marshall Cook.
