SIOUX CITY METROS Kansas City blanks Metros in semis

AMES, Iowa | Dawson Engle and Zach Curry scored two goals apiece as the Kansas City Jets rolled to a 7-0 win over the Sioux City Metros in the Midwest High School Hockey League Varsity Championship Tournament Saturday at Ames/ ISU Ice Arena on Saturday.

Engle has 24 goals and 45 assists this season for the West Division champions, who will take a 27-1-1-1 record into Sunday afternoon's 1 o'clock championship game. Engle put the Jets on the scoreboard with an unassisted goal, 3:34 into the game, and later added a third-period goal.

Curry has 34 goals and 27 assists for the second-seeded Jets. He scored goals in the second and third periods for a team that posted a 31-23 shots-on-goal advantage.

Sioux City (15-13-1-1), the MHSHL Tournament's sixth seed, was blanked for only the second time this season.

Goaltender Carter Manthorne converted 13 of 18 save attempts in 23 minutes. Ben Morehead had 11 of 13 saves in 27 minutes.

The Metros will play the tournament's thirdplace game Saturday, starting at 11 a.m.
