Sinnott sets record in Warriors' win

WATERLOO — Ben Sinnott racked up four goals Friday night to set a new Midwest High School Hockey League record as the Waterloo Warriors bounced

back from their first regulation loss of the season with a 7-2 victory over the Des Moines Oak Leafs at Young Arena.

Sinnott's big night put him at 53 goals for the sea-



son, erasing the previous record of 52 owned by Joseph Harcharik of the Oak Leafs. A junior from Waterloo Columbus, Sinnott now has 89 points on the season.

Carter Herbst and Sinnott each scored in the first 3 minutes, 19 seconds, then both scored again later in the opening period as the Warriors built a 4-0 lead.

Sinnott connected for his third goal in the second period to make it 5-0, but the

Oak Leafs (15-14-0-1) came back with one goal in the second and another :39 into the third to make it 5-2.

Sinnott made it a four-goal hat trick at the 7:04 mark of the third and Cobie Morrissey capped the scoring just over seven minutes later.

Kole Latusick had four assists for Waterloo (26-1-0-1) and Ethan Fox had a pair. Chase Pabst stopped 24 shots in goal.

Waterloo plays at Kansas City Saturday and Sunday.
