Warriors deliver opening statement

Latusick, Raisty propel Waterloo to 5-0 win

AMES – Kole Latusick had a hat trick and Caleb Raisty turned away 31 shots as the Waterloo Warriors opened the Midwest High School Hockey League tournament with a 5-0 win over the Des Moines Oak Leafs Friday night.



After a scoreless first period, **Latusick** scored twice in the second period as part of a three-goal Warrior outburst, and completed the hat trick midway through the third period.

Latusick scored just 1 minute and 22 seconds into the second period on an assist from Ben Sinnott, and then scored four minutes later unassisted. JP Smith made it 3-0 just 45 seconds after Latusick's second goal.

Latusick scored short-handed to complete the hat trick before Landen Schoonover capped off the Warriors scoring.
